ACTION ALERT! Urge Your Member of Congress to Sign a Letter in Support of the Carbon Neutrality of Biomass Energy!

Representatives Reid Ribble (R-WI) and Sanford Bishop (D-GA) are currently circulating for signatures a bi-partisan letter to EPA Administrator McCarthy, Department of Energy Secretary Moniz, and USDA Secretary Vilsack in support of biomass energy as a sustainable, responsible, renewable, and economically significant energy source.

Paper and wood products mills use biomass residuals from their manufacturing operations to produce bioenergy that provides significant carbon reducing benefits. Although the revised EPA Framework for Assessing Biogenic CO₂ Emissions From Stationary Sources released in November 2014 provides a step in the right direction on the carbon neutrality of some types of biomass, the forest products industry needs greater certainty regarding the carbon neutrality of our biomass energy. This letter calls for federal policies that consistently reflect biomass' carbon neutrality.
