Grow the Vote *Update*



ACTION ALERT! Ask your Member of Congress to Vote Yes on H.R. 4775, the Ozone Standards Implementation Act!

The U.S. House of Representatives is expected to vote soon on critical legislation that will correct some of the flaws in the current Clean Air Act.

H.R. 4775, introduced by Representatives Pete Olson (R-TX), Bill Flores (R-TX), Steve Scalise (R-LA), Bob Latta (R-OH), Kevin McCarthy (R-CA), and Henry Cuellar (D-TX), would prevent a rushed implementation of the 2015 ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) and avoid potentially disruptive effects on and significant costs to the forest products industry.

H.R. 4775:

- Sets a 10-year implementation schedule for the 2015 ozone NAAQS to provide states time to complete work on implementing the 2008 ozone standard,
- Requires EPA to issue implementation guidance concurrent with any NAAQS revision,
- Adjusts the NAAQS review cycle to 10 years, establishing a more realistic review cycle, and
- Provides important relief for Prevention of Significant Deterioration permits.

Our industry has already invested billions of dollars to help make our air clearer while making products essential for everyday life. The bipartisan legislation will allow air quality improvements to continue without causing local communities to miss out on new jobs and economic growth as industry sectors face the risk of becoming uncompetitive in the global marketplace.
